

**RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF
IMPERIAL DECLARING APRIL 2-8, 2007 AS "IMPERIAL COUNTY PUBLIC
HEALTH WEEK"**

WHEREAS, the American Public Health Association has designated the first full week in April as Public Health Week, and

WHEREAS, National Public Health Week is a time to raise awareness regarding the role that local Public Health Departments play in promoting wellness; and

WHEREAS, a National Public Health Week provides the opportunity to recognize the contributions of Public Health the Nation's well being and well as focus attention on our major Public Health issues, and

WHEREAS, the Imperial County Public Health Department adopts the theme for 2007, as "*Take the First Step and Gives Special Focus to Preparedness Against Public Health Threats*", and

WHEREAS, all communities must plan in advance to ensure their residents can respond effectively to a public health emergency, and

WHEREAS, most Americans remain largely unprepared for a Public Health Emergency, and


WHEREAS, Emergency Preparedness for Healthcare Providers and the business community present are of high priority, and

WHEREAS, the nations most vulnerable populations including the indigent, elderly and children are often impacted disproportionately by Public Health Emergencies, and


