

**RESOLUTION OF THE IMPERIAL COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS  
AUTHORIZING DESTRUCTION OF RECORDS BY THE IMPERIAL COUNTY  
SHERIFF'S OFFICE**

**Resolution No. 2008-021**

WHEREAS, Government Code Section 26202.6 provides that the Board of Supervisors may authorize a department head to destroy recordings of telephone and radio communications upon certain conditions; and


WHEREAS, the Sheriff has telephone and radio dispatch recordings made from 1992 through 2005 that can no longer be played by the Sheriff because a new system was put in place in 2006; and


WHEREAS, these recordings are all more than 100 days old, are not evidence related to any claim or pending litigation or any known potential or threatened claims or litigation, and are no longer related to any incident report; and

WHEREAS, County Counsel consents to such destruction;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Supervisors hereby authorizes the Sheriff to destroy telephone and radio dispatch recordings made from 1992 through 2005 that can no longer be played.
